Ensure your application is submitted prior to Feb. 1st –PAID

You will have 3 choices at a cost of \$156 and any extra university choice will be \$50 added on.

University –What I need to know!

- Know where your program(s) are offered
- Meet with a representative for the university to get first hand info
- Know the pre-requisites for your program(s)
- Know the minimum marks required and possible average(s) overall for your minimum “6” -4u/4m courses-verify you have 6 U or M courses on your status sheet.
- The initial application includes all final grades from completed Grade 11 and 12 courses and a list of all current-year courses in progress.
- Ensure your application is submitted prior to January 13th–PAID

- EX: For One year
- Algonquin for Business -Domestic tuition/ancillary fees: \$2,591.81 for one year - residence is extra
- Algonquin- Outdoor adventure: Domestic tuition/ancillary fees:\$5,042.90 for one year .
